


March was gone in a blink of an eye, and we have many activities to share with all of you!

Our community organizers were busy attending different events with our Latino communities throughout Georgia!

We engaged in community clean-up and embellishment activities at Forest Park. In Gainesville, we presented at a Spanish-English immersion at World Language Academy Middle School. We had the chance to discuss their role in GALEO and why we must promote civic engagement within our Latino Community. In Fulton County, we met at a Town Hall with our Latino families at the Palmetto Elementary School. We had the chance to connect with parents about school safety and ways to get involved in their children's education. At the Capitol of Georgia, we were present for Environmental Justice Day and issued a call to action for lawmakers to enact clean air and water policies. Also, we participated in a special students program at the King Center, where different schools in metro Atlanta went for a day. Kudos to King Center; it promotes Martin Luther King Jr teachings and positively impacts the youth!
