



House Party Exercise

Now that we have completed the survey, we would like to do a little exercise in the form of a role-play, and we will want to capture notes. The quantitative data in the survey and qualitative from this exercise will give us a more robust understanding of our community.

Scenario:

You have been appointed the Mayor, Governor, or President, and you have ONE issue you can resolve. What would you resolve, and how would you address it? Everyone else will play a constituent. The Mayor, Gov, or President have come to answer their constituents about their decision.

Exercise notes:

1. Break into groups of not more than 5-6 people
2. Provide note card(s) and pen(s)
3. Quickly select one person to play Mayor, Gov, or President and one to take notes.
4. Constituents should feel free to play any role a constituent would play (agree or disagree)
5. Mayor, Gov, and President can make up any static, within reason
6. After the role-play is over, if time allows, switch up roles and repeat
7. When the Townhall/House Party concludes, please complete this debrief form with all the notes from the exercise.
